**RE: Yr 11 Core Mock Period**

Scheduled on our school calendar is a Core Mock Period for our Year 11s which sees students sit practice papers in the Core 5 subjects: English, maths, science, history, geography and French. The core mock periods dates are: 10<sup>th</sup> -17<sup>th</sup> March. These exams serve an important purpose in assessing your daughter's current progress, whilst providing real exam experience in preparation for the summer ones she is scheduled to sit soon.

The scheduling of the core mock period has been carefully chosen to ensure sufficient time for feedback and revision before students begin their actual exams for the summer exam series. This should also support their Easter school sign-up decisions.

The Core Mock Period exams will be sat in examination conditions.

In between exams in period 3 and 4, students attend lessons as normal. No students will be allowed off site until the end of the last exam each day, except on Tuesday 11<sup>th</sup>, 14<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup> March where only French/Spanish students stay for their language exams.

All morning exams begin at 8:15am, therefore all students should go straight to the tennis courts for registration before their exam start. As with all exams, students are expected to sit their exams in full school uniform. This is also a good time to ensure your daughter has a clear pencil case and all the equipment she needs in her exams.

Please check the yellow 'please note' box as this outlines what afternoons some students will be allowed home from 12:40pm.
